

Bible verses that support the list of truth about who I am in God:

I am fearfully and wonderfully made by God

For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place, when I was woven together in the depths of the earth. (Psalm 139:13-15)

You made me; you created me. (Psalm 119:73)

Yet you, LORD, are our Father. We are the clay, you are the potter; we are all the work of your hand. (Isaiah 64:8)

I am made for purpose

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. (Ephesians 2:10)

I am made in God's image

So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. (Genesis 1:27)

I am chosen

You have been set apart as holy to the Lord your God, and he has chosen you from all the nations of the earth to be his own special treasure. (Deuteronomy 14:2)

For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love he predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will—to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves. (Ephesians 1:4-6)

Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I set you apart and appointed you a prophet to the nations. (Jeremiah 1:5)

For we know, brothers and sisters loved by God, that he has chosen you. (1 Thessalonians 1:4)

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy. (Peter 2:9-10)

I am Unique

But in fact God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. If they were all one part, where would the body be? As it is, there are many parts, but one body. (1 Corinthians 12:18-20)

I am a child of God

For you are all children of God through faith in Christ Jesus. (Galatians 3:26)

So you are no longer a slave, but God's child; and since you are his child, God has made you also an heir. (Galatians 4:7)

See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! (1 John 3:1)

I am part of God's family

Pointing to his disciples, he said, "here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of my father in heaven is my brother and sister and mother." (Matthew 12:49-50)

Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also members of his household. (Ephesians 2:19)

So in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. (Romans 12:5)

I am a citizen of heaven

But we are citizens of heaven, where the Lord Jesus Christ lives. And we are eagerly waiting for him to return as our Savior. He will take our weak mortal bodies and change them into glorious bodies like his own, using the same power with which he will bring everything under his control. (Philippians 3:20-21)

I am a friend of Christ

Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends. (John 15:13)

I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. (John 15:15)

I am complete in Christ

And in Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the head over every power and authority. Colossians 2:10

I am loved

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. (Galatians 2:20)

For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:38-39)

Follow God's example, therefore, as dearly loved children, and walk in the way of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God. (Ephesians 5:1-2)

I am saved (from death into life)

He has saved us and called us to a holy life – not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. (2 Timothy 1:9)

But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions – it is by grace you have been saved. (Ephesians 2: 4-5)

I am forgiven

I am writing to you, dear children, because your sins have been forgiven on account of his name. (1 John 2:12)

In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace. (Ephesians 1:7)

There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. (Romans 8:1)

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. (Romans 3:23-24)

I am free

We have been set free because of what Christ has done. Through his blood our sins have been forgiven. We have been set free because God's grace is so rich. (Ephesians 1:7)

For in Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life has set you free from the law of sin and death. (Romans 8:2)

I am known and understood

You have searched me, LORD, and you know me. You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. (Psalm 139:1)

You know when I sit down or stand up. You know my thoughts even when I'm far away. You see me when I travel and when I rest at home. You know everything I do. You know what I am going to say even before I say it, LORD. (Psalm 139:2-4)

The LORD gave me this message: "I knew you before I formed you in your mother's womb. Before you were born I set you apart and appointed you as my prophet to the nations." (Jeremiah 1:4-5)

You saw me before I was born. Every day of my life was recorded in your book. Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed. (Psalm 139:16)

I am a conqueror / I am victorious

Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. (Romans 8:37)

But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Corinthians 15:57)

I will go before you and will level the mountains; I will break down gates of bronze and cut through bars of iron. (Isaiah 45:2)

I am a new creation – my past does not define me

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. (Corinthians 5:17)

And to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness. (Ephesians 4:24)

I am blessed

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. (Ephesians 1:3)

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. From the house of the Lord we bless you. (Psalm 118:26)

I am precious

Because you are precious in my eyes, and honoured, and I love you, I give men in return for you, peoples in exchange for your life. (Isaiah 43:4)

I am brave

The wicked flee though no one pursues, but the righteous are bold as a lion. (Proverbs 28:1)

I am strong

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. (Philippians 4:13)

But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint. (Isaiah 40:31)

I am beautiful

How beautiful you are, my darling! Oh, how beautiful! Your eyes behind your veil are doves. Your hair is like a flock of goats descending from the hills of Gilead. (Song of Solomon 4:1)

You are altogether beautiful, my darling; there is no flaw in you. (Song of Solomon 4:7)

You are as beautiful as Tirzah, my darling, as lovely as Jerusalem, as majestic as troops with banners. Turn your eyes from me; they overwhelm me. Your hair is like a flock of goats descending from Gilead. (Song of Solomon 6:4-5)

I am an heir of God – a son or daughter, royalty

Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory. (Romans 8:17)

I am holy

But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation. (Colossians 1:22)

Therefore as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. (Colossians 3:12)

I am the light of the world

You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot. You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven. (Matthew 5:13-16)

That is why, for the sake of Christ, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong. (2 Corinthians 12:10)

I am the righteousness of God

God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. (2 Corinthians 5:21)

And be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ – the righteousness that comes from God on the basis of faith. (Philippians 3:9)

I am the apple of God's eye

For whoever touches you touches the apple of his eye. (Zechariah 2:8)

Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings. (Psalm 17:8)

I am treasured

Now if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you will be my treasured possession out of all the nations—for the whole earth is mine. (Exodus 19:5)

For you are a people holy to the LORD your God. The LORD your God has chosen you to be a people for His prized possession, above all peoples on the face of the earth. (Deuteronomy 7:6)

I am valuable

What is the price of two sparrows—one copper coin? But not a single sparrow can fall to the ground without your Father knowing it. And the very hairs on your head are all numbered. So don't be afraid; you are more valuable to God than a whole flock of sparrows. (Matthew 10:29-31)

For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect. (1 Peter 1:18-19)

I am successful

I can do all this through him who gives me strength. (Philippians 4:13)

Do this so that you may prosper in all you do and wherever you go (1 Kings 2:3)

I, even I, have spoken; yes, I have called him. I will bring him, and he will succeed in his mission. (Isaiah 48:15)

I am powerful

For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline. (2 Timothy 1:7)

“No weapon forged against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord and this is their vindication from me,” declares the Lord. (Isaiah 54:17)

I am a masterpiece

For we are God’s workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. (Ephesians 2:10)

I am the temple of God

Don’t you know that you yourselves are God’s temple and that God’s Spirit dwells in your midst? (1 Corinthians 3:16)

I am accepted

Accept one another, then, just as Christ has accepted you, in order to bring praise to God. (Romans 15:7)

I am surrounded by God’s love

Many are the woes of the wicked, but the Lord’s unfailing love surrounds the one who trusts in him. (Psalm 32:10)

I have everything I need

Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? (Matthew 6:26)

So do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. Matthew 6:31-33

For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. (Jeremiah 29:11)
